



## **HIGHLIGHTS: JANUARY 2021**

- Wisconsin businesses exported \$1,859,069,296 worth of products during the first month of 2021. That was
  13.56% more than in January 2020, but 2.6% less than the monthly total in December 2020. Total U.S. exports
  were down by 1.15% compared to January 2019. Only 10 states saw a larger percentage increase between
  January 2020 and 2021. Wisconsin ranks #19 among the 50 states in exports.
- Switzerland breaks into Wisconsin's top five export destinations thanks to a nearly \$60 million jump in
  purchases of aviation and aerospace equipment. Wisconsin's exports of medical and scientific instruments to
  Switzerland also grew by 431.9%. With \$18.9 million worth of vaccines being shipped from Wisconsin to
  Belgium (compared to \$0 in January 2020), total exports to Belgium grew by 75.05% and the country ranks #7.
- While the major jump in aviation and aerospace exports, Wisconsin's #6 export category, was due to shipments to just Switzerland, the industrial machinery category expanded by \$27.2 million due to increased shipments across a number of countries and product subcategories. Bulldozers, graders and scrapers grew by 221.5%, harvesting machines grew by 47.2% and heat-treating equipment grew by 103.0%. Exports of paper products, which primarily go to Canada, declined by 11.1%.
- Total Wisconsin imports increased by 7.4% in January 2021 compared to January 2020. Industrial machinery, the largest category of Wisconsin's imports, grew by 34.9%. China is the source for the largest volume of industrial machinery imports. Vietnam now places second among import sources, after a 2,133.1% increase.
